Qualification requirements for BOD candidates:

A board member candidate must be at least of 25 years of age. He or she should be known to be of sound moral conduct and character. He or she must be a valid ICNE voting member for three consecutive years including the current year as defined below:

1. Voting membership is gained in the second year after paying the membership dues in a timely manner for two years;
2. A nominee must be a voting member for three consecutive years. Since the voting membership is gained in the second year, a nominee must have paid dues in a timely manner for four years consecutively to qualify as a candidate.

A BOD candidate must have served on at least one committee for at least two years (including the current year when the election is to be held and during one of the previous two years). A current year committee member and the current chair of the committee or two current year committee members where the prospective candidate served OR ten voting members must endorse the nomination (applicable when the candidate has served on a committee but no committee member is available to sign his nomination). A current chair of a committee (i.e., a current board member) who wishes to be nominated for re-election must be endorsed by a member of the board and a committee member of his or her own committee. Two year committee membership of a candidate should be validated using timely submitted and approved committee proposals (of the current year when the election is to be held and during one of the previous two years).

Close relatives such as brother, sister, spouses, parents, direct in-laws, children and their spouses, grand children and their spouses of any current ICNE full time employees cannot be members of the ICNE board. No more than one person from the same family can be nominated or serve on the ICNE Board (i.e., Close relatives such as brother, sister, spouses, parents, direct in-laws, children and their spouses, grand children and their spouses). **In case of more than one nomination from close relatives are submitted from the same family, all nominations will be rejected.**

A board member candidate must be a US citizen or US permanent resident (green card holder). Must have read and agreed to abide by ICNE Articles of Organization and Bylaws.

Current or previous board members who have served 2 full terms are ineligible to run in the BOD election.
